Perfect harmony

L'Ambiente: traditional, but à la page

To re-voke history with current and unusual lines. Celebrating tradition by daring a pure and minimal design in a house dating back to 1500.

We are near Feltre, a characteristic village of Valbelluna, in a historic Venetian villa with evident rural connotations; once used by sharecroppers, it has been renovated several times but without ever losing its identity. For the latest restyling the workers have been directed by L'Ambiente, a well-known reality in the world of interior design, in particular by Maurizio Scotti from the Cesiomaggiore showroom. They have shaped a comfortable and harmonious habitat, redefining new spaces and uses of the rooms without distorting them from their conformity. The first challenge, that of generating a suggestive connection between the different rooms, was won with the ADL doors, designed to be a light filter between the rooms, with a pivot opening and slightly shaded glass. The floors, on the other hand, made of different materials, define the boundaries between the rooms: oak wood with a Hungarian herringbone for the living room, old larch in the sleeping area, a rustic stone cladding for the kitchen.
